Rather than being a physical boundary of separation, the Apennines have been for centuries a place of exchange between human and non-human cultures. However, today they are perceived in a contradictory way: on one hand, as backward margins, on the other as an ideal natural refuge. In response to recent crises, inland areas like the Apennines are receiving renewed attention due to their natural and cultural resources. There is a growing need to consider this territory as a collective space, a common good that fosters new projects and territorial alliances. To support this vision, the contribution uses Matthew Gandy's concept of "Metropolitan Nature," exploring how water infrastructures, such as the Peschiera-Capore aqueduct, unexpectedly connect the mountains to the city of Rome, revealing reciprocal infuences and conflicts between nature and urbanization.

The verticality of the Apennine orography blocks the rain, giving rise to the bodies of water present in the valley. Thus, through the interaction between rainfall and its infiltration into the soil, the many springs form the hydrographic network from which the Sabato river originates.
	The layering of urbanization in the Sabato river valley shapes its nature. Canalizations, waterfalls, concrete banks, and barriers have altered it over time, turning it into a completely anthropic feature. In this context, a reading is proposed that contrasts the presence and potential of water, which exists in many forms within the Sabato river basin, with the difficulty of accessing these hydraulic forms, which could serve as potential points for both human and non-human relations.

Every summer, the city of Rome experiences high temperatures, leading to harmful effects on human health and increased energy consumption due to cooling measures. Public space can offer moments of relief in the form of microclimatic shelters. FRIGIDARIUM leverages the beneficial effects of rainwater and the fountains scattered along the city's streets, parks, and squares.
	Pediluvio is a shallow pool, the size of two parallel parking spaces, allowing people to immerse their feet up to the ankles while walking or sitting. Serbatoio is a 1,000-liter tank with a large funnel that collects rainwater, making it available—especially during dry periods—for wetting feet and hands, cooling down hot surfaces, and watering plants. Nasone is the classic Roman drinking fountain that continuously provides fresh potable water. When not in direct use, its flow can be redirected to fill the Pediluvio, the Serbatoio, and countless other cooling installations across the city. FRIGIDARIUM is an installation developed by architecture students from
	Roma Tre University and Sapienza University of Rome, along with tutors, for the FAR 2024 Architecture Festival, in collaboration with the ARCHA Association. The initiative is part of PED4ALL, a research project conducted by the Department of Architecture at Roma Tre University in partnership with Municipio VIII and other European partners.

Yet, the environmental crisis urges us to imagine alliances between territories that transcend the urban-rural dualism, fostering synergies between local and proximate conditions and the regional to planetary scale.
